April 21 – July 8, 2012

All artists residing within 250 miles of the City of Erie are invited to enter works not previously exhibited in the Erie area.

Prizes

A total of \$10,000: cash awards of \$2,500, including the Northwestern Pennsylvania Artists Association Award, and \$7,500 in guaranteed purchases. The cash awards will be divided among the juror's selections of the best works in the show. There may also be juror's mentions. Purchase selections will be made by the firms and individuals offering purchase awards.

Juror

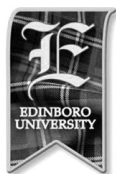


Emily Hubley will serve as Juror of Selection and Awards. A noted animator and filmmaker, Ms. Hubley's films have been exhibited widely in museums, art houses, universities and film festivals, including Sundance, Tribeca and South by Southwest. Her artwork has been presented in exhibitions at galleries and museums around the country, including the Museum of Modern Art in New

York. Ms. Hubley has been making animated short films for thirty years. Her hand-drawn films explore personal memory and the turbulence of emotional life. Among her many shorts are *Octave*, *Pigeon Within*, *Delivery Man*, *Her Grandmother's Gift* (in collaboration with her mother, Faith) and *The Tower* (in collaboration with her sister, Georgia, a frequent collaborator and founding member of the alternative rock group Yo La Tengo). Her company, Hubbub, Inc., has created shorts for series for the cable networks Nickelodeon and Lifetime, and Ms. Hubley has created the animated sequences in numerous feature films, including John Cameron Mitchell's *Hedwig and the Angry Inch*, Barak Goodman and John Magglio's *The Boy in the Bubble*, and *What's on Your Plate?* by Catherine Gund, among many others.

Ms. Hubley's first feature length film, *The Toe Tactic*, premiered at the Museum of Modern Art in 2009. It was described by New York Magazine as "an arrestingly whimsical family drama about innocence lost and urban yearning that mixed offbeat live action and surreal animation." Ms. Hubley grew up in the arts; her parents are Academy Award-winning animators John and Faith Hubley. She likes to make her films look "...handmade. I want to make the analog process have equal time with the digital process. They use different parts of your brain. I'm happy when I'm drawing... Clicking [the mouse], sometimes not so happy."

The Erie Art Museum is pleased to partner once again with the art department of Edinboro University of Pennsylvania to bring Emily Hubley to Erie.



In addition to serving as juror for the Spring Show, Ms. Hubley will engage with students and faculty at Edinboro, and present a public lecture on **Thursday, March 29, at 7 pm** in Doucette Hall Room 119 at EUP.

How To Enter

Fees

Each entrant may submit up to 3 works. Entry fee is \$5 per entry for members of the Erie Art Museum and \$15 per entry for all others. Fees are not refundable. Fees for those works not hand-delivered must be paid by check or money order made payable to the Erie Art Museum. There is a \$15 handling fee for out-of-town works entered by shipment and the return shipping cost must also be included.

Labels

Attached labels should be completely filled out and fixed securely to the upper left corner of the back of each two-dimensional work, and to the underside in the case of sculpture or structure. If a work is not for sale, this should be indicated on both entry blank and label. For graphics, artists should indicate on back of entry form the size of the edition, the number of prints available for sale, and the price for matted, unframed prints, as well as the price of the framed print entered in the show.

Framing

All works, including graphics, drawings, photographs, etc., must be properly framed, wired, and ready for hanging. Corner clips and similar non-frame mounts are not acceptable.

Media

Works in all media may be entered, including painting, photography, graphics, sculpture, etc. Works should not exceed 72 inches in any dimension or weigh more than 100 pounds. Artists proposing to submit works requiring specialized installation should confer with Museum staff well before entry deadline.

Delivery

Calendar

Work will be accepted at the **Erie Art Museum Custom House entrance**, located at 411 State Street on Saturday, March 10, 11 am – 5 pm; Sunday, March 18, 1 pm–5 pm; Friday, March 23, 11 am–9 pm; Saturday, March 24, 11 am – 5 pm and Sunday, March 25, 1 pm – 5 pm. Out-of-town works may be submitted by prepaid shipment. Entry form and appropriate fees, including handling and return shipping fee, should be enclosed with works. **Deadline for entries is Sunday, March 25 at 5 pm** (Shipped works must be received by Saturday, March 24, 2012.) Works arriving after that time will not be considered. Ship works to Erie Art Museum Frame Shop, 423 State Street, Erie PA 16501.

Judging

Notification of acceptance or rejection will be mailed to each entrant upon completion of the judging.

Opening

A private preview and reception for the artists and members of the Erie Art Museum will be held on **Saturday, April 21, from 7 to 9:30 pm**. Prizes will be awarded at this time. The Spring Show will be open to the public on Sunday, April 22, at 1 pm. The exhibition will close Sunday, July 8, 2012.

Closing

Works not accepted for the exhibition **MUST** be picked up at the Erie Art Museum **Custom House entrance** on Saturday, April 7, 11 am – 5 pm; Saturday, April 14, 11 am – 5 pm; and Sunday, April 15, 1 pm – 5 pm. Last day to pick up will be Saturday, April 21, 11 am – 9:30 pm. **The Erie Art Museum will not be responsible for rejected works not picked up by April 21.** All works accepted for the exhibit must remain until the close of the show Sunday, July 8, 2012. Works may then be picked up Tuesday, July 10 through Thursday, July 12 from 11 am – 5 pm; Friday, July 13, 11 am – 9 pm; Saturday, July 14, 11 am – 5 pm and Sunday, July 15, 1 – 5 pm.

Conditions & Instructions

Although due caution will be taken to guard works and frames from injury, all entries must be exhibited at the artist's own risk. No accepted work may be withdrawn before the close of the show. If an artist indicates that a work is not for sale, it may still qualify for an award. Sales are encouraged. The standard commission of 25% will be charged on all sales, including patron purchases. The Erie Art Museum reserves the right to photographically reproduce any accepted work for publicity or educational purposes.

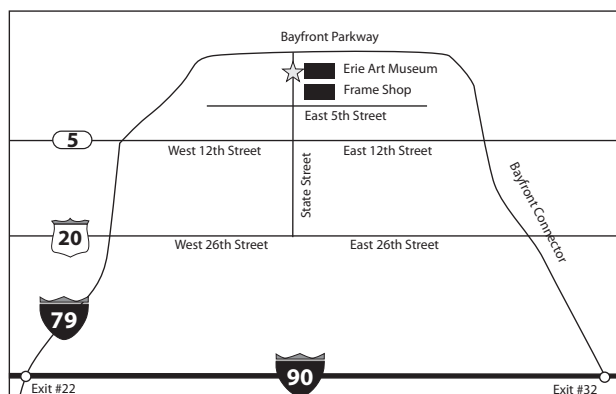
From West - Take I-90 East to Exit 22, follow I-79 North as above.
